

E.164 Phone Number Formatting

1. A + (plus) sign
2. International Country Calling code – [Get Country Code Click Here](#)
3. Local Area code
4. Local Phone number

For example, here's a US-based number in standard local formatting: (415) 555-2671

(415) 555 - 2671
AREA CODE PHONE NUMBER

Here's the same phone number in E.164 formatting: +14155552671

+ 1 415 5552671
+ COUNTRY CODE AREA CODE PHONE NUMBER

Dialing Mobile Phone Numbers

In a number of countries internationally, local dialing may require the addition of a '0' in front of the subscriber number. With E.164 formatting, this '0' must usually be removed.

For example, here's a UK-based number in standard local formatting: 020 7183 8750

020 7183 8750
AREA CODE PHONE NUMBER

Here's the same phone number in E.164 formatting: +442071838750

+ 44 20 7183 8750
+ COUNTRY CODE AREA CODE PHONE NUMBER

Notice: When calling a mobile phone from Mexico, E.164 formatting requires a '1' be added after the country code.

For example, a local wireless number in Mexico City 55 1234 1234 would become +52 1 55 1234 1234 when using E.164 formatting. This call will not be completed successfully if missing the added '1'.
